# Website Accessibility Policy

## 1. Our Commitment

Retro Reset Ltd is committed to making our website accessible and usable for everyone, regardless of ability or technology. Our website is a key part of how we share our mobile computer museum, educational activities, and community events, and we want everyone to be able to engage with us equally.

While our website uses a retro-inspired design and colour palette in keeping with our mission, we ensure that accessibility is never compromised by aesthetic choices.

## 2. Standards and Guidelines

We aim to meet the **Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 AA** level of compliance. These internationally recognised standards ensure content is:

- **Perceivable** – Information is available to all senses;
  - **Operable** – Interface forms, controls, and navigation are usable;
  - **Understandable** – Content is readable and predictable;
  - **Robust** – Content works well with current and future technologies, including assistive tools.

## 3. Design with Inclusion in Mind

Our website incorporates retro colours, fonts, and styling in homage to computing history. However, we carefully balance these elements to remain accessible:

- **Contrast:** All colour combinations used meet or exceed the minimum contrast ratios required for legibility;
- **Typography:** Retro fonts are used for headings or accent features only — not for body text or navigation;
- **Responsiveness:** Our site adapts to mobile, tablet, and desktop screens;
- **Keyboard navigation:** All menus, links, and interactive elements are accessible via keyboard;
- **Alt text:** All non-decorative images include descriptive alternative text;
- **ARIA labels:** Where appropriate, we use ARIA (Accessible Rich Internet Applications) tags to support assistive technologies.

## 4. Known Limitations

While we strive for full accessibility, we acknowledge that:

- Some older embedded media (e.g. archived retro content or third-party video players) may not meet current standards;
- Certain highly stylised visual features may create challenges for users with specific visual impairments.


We are continuously working to improve these areas.
